The goal of this contest is to have fun but put into practice a skill that will be required for the canoe trip in June. On the canoe trip you will buddy up with one or two more Scouts to share a canoe, tent and of course meals. That is why we are looking for a meal for two vice just one for yourself.

Don't have supper, because one of the meals will be yours, the other meal will be tasted by the judges.

The rules of the contest are as follow:

1. The meal must serve two people.
2. The meal will be an example of your supper for the second or third day of the canoe trip.
3. It may be cooked over a fire or stove.
4. You will not have refrigeration of any kind on a canoe trip.
5. Judging will be based on the following criteria:
  - a. Packing – Size and weight
  - b. Ease of cooking
  - c. Survivability – without refrigeration
  - d. Taste

You will be provided with a fire or camp stove to cook your meal upon.

You will need to provide every thing else you need to cook your meal.
